The Assessment Process

Rosecrance offers confidential assessments to determine if a substance use disorder exists based on formal criteria from the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) and the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders-V (DSM-V). A recommendation and plan is developed during the comprehensive assessment involving the referring medical professionals. Any additional factors are identified that contribute to, or are related to, the substance use disorder.

Drug Testing/Interpreting Results

ASAM recommends drug testing where medically appropriate in clinical diagnostic settings. When a patient is assessed for a substance use disorder, it is essential for the health care provider to have objective evidence about the recent substance use of the patient. Drug testing can provide evidence of current or recent exposure to intoxicants, which can be a means of verifying the client's substance use history as reported by the client.
