Seeking treatment for substance use and mental health disorders is particularly critical for veteran service members and for their families. Our physician-led team delivers outcomes-informed residential treatment at our Rosecrance Harrison Campus in Rockford, Illinois. Specialized programming incorporates occupational factors and traumas into the treatment experience, along with experiential and recreational therapies, individual and group counseling, 12-Step support, and medication-assisted treatment.

Rosecrance is an approved provider through the VA-CCN to support you and your patient, reducing the financial barriers for the lifesaving care we provide. **Through this partnership, your patient will receive residential care, regular updates will be provided to you, and your patient will return to your care at discharge.**

THE PROCESS

Determine eligibility

Individuals may qualify for care from a provider outside the VA hospital/clinic system if they are enrolled in or are eligible for community care. The VA must approve a request to seek care from a community provider, and VA staff make all eligibility decisions.

Make an appointment

Start by calling Rosecrance on our VIP line at 815.222.7180 to initiate a referral or to ask questions and gather more information.

Getting care

Once we've received the referral and medical documentation, our team will walk your patient through the assessment to determine the best treatment plan.
